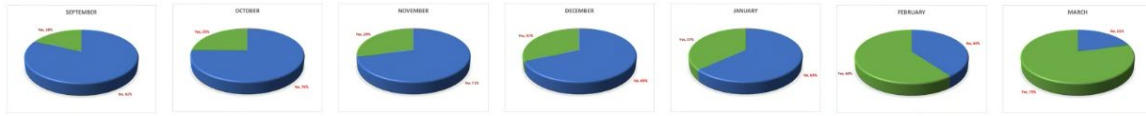
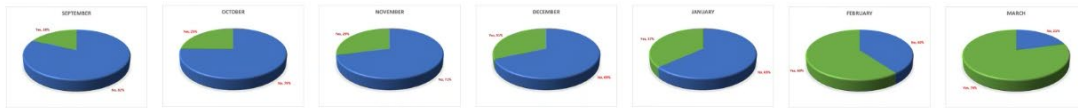
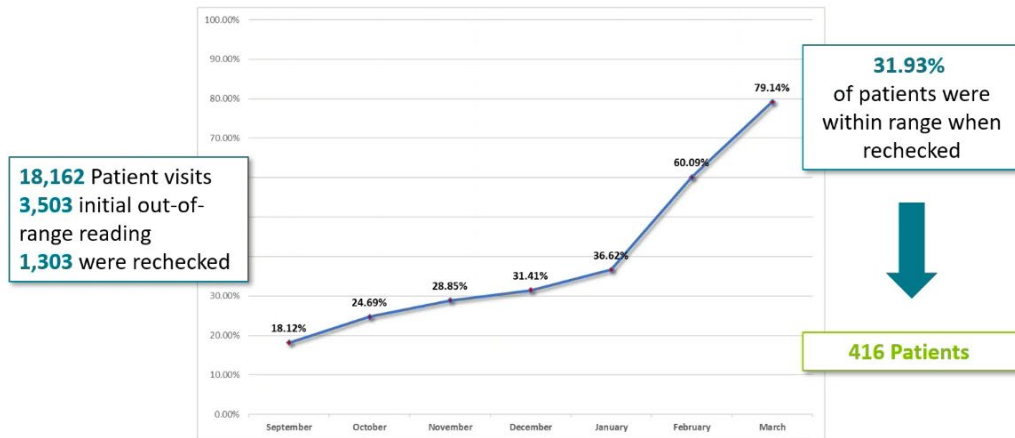

Meet Your Measures: Blood Pressure

Why do we take blood pressure twice?

When a patient's initial blood pressure reading is >139 systolic and/or 89 diastolic, take it again!



30%

of patients have a second blood pressure reading within range.

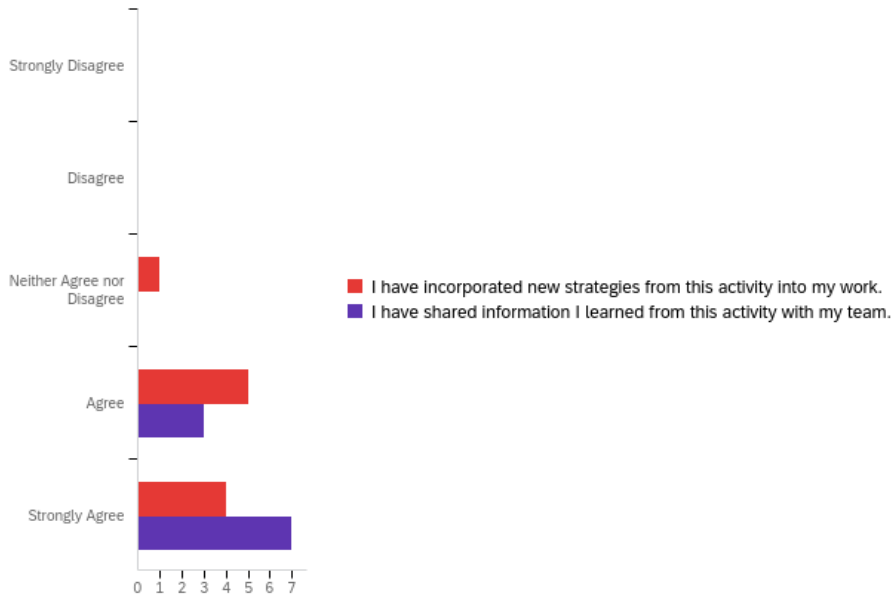
A second reading is beneficial because...

- Creates more accurate patient records
- Reduces unnecessary patient anxiety
- Prevents over-medicating patients

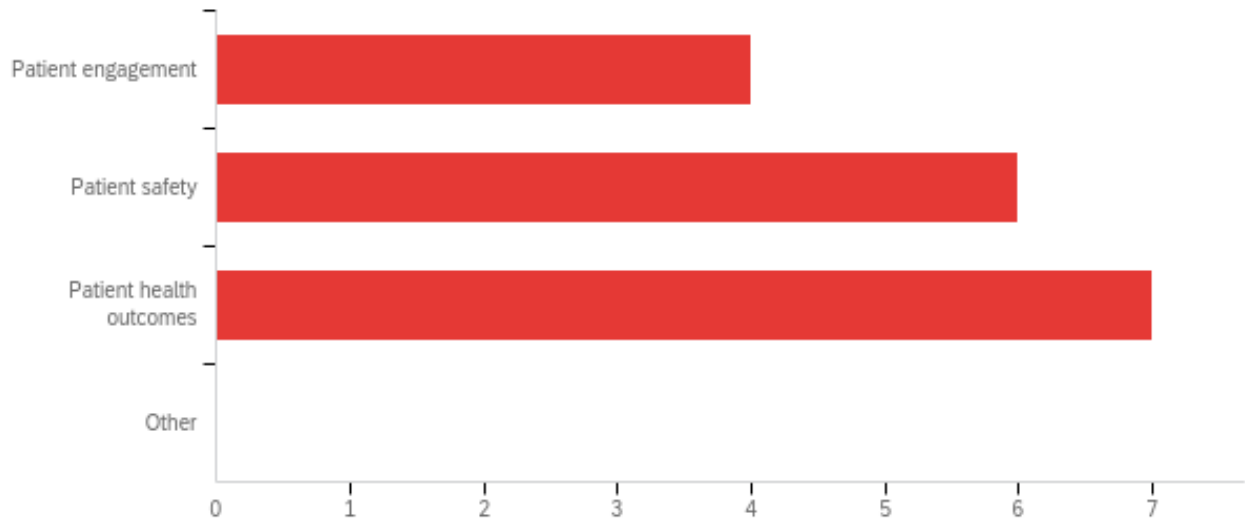

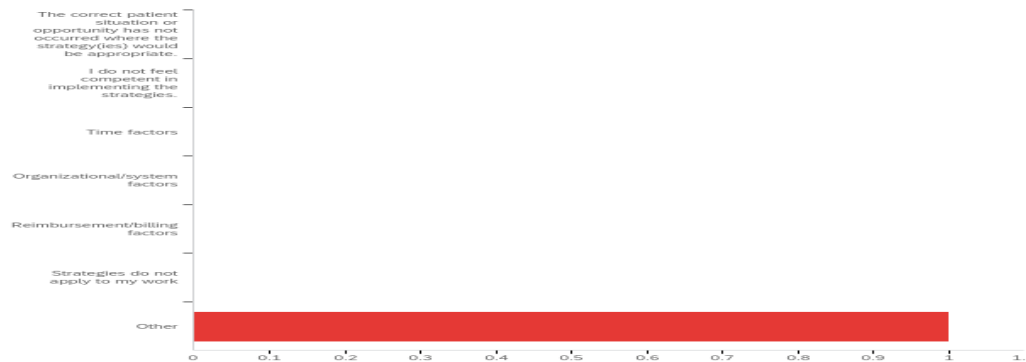

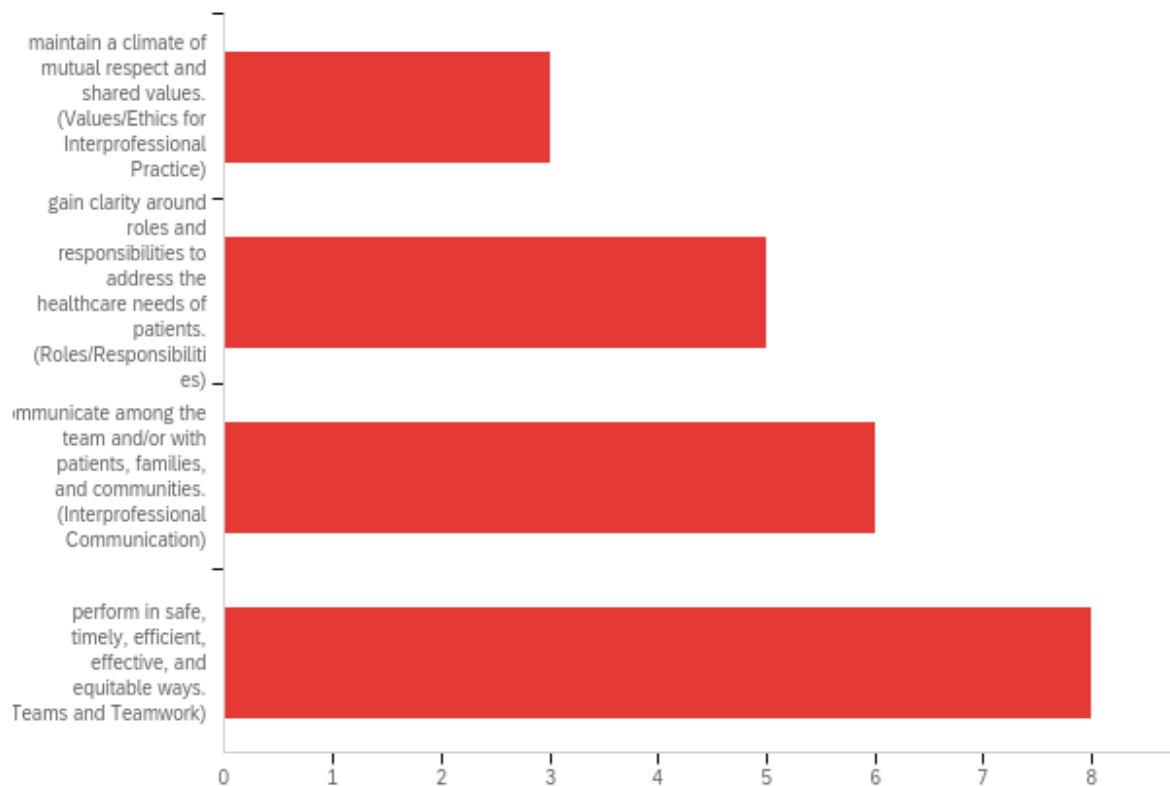
